
CLINICAL INFORMATION FOR NURSING

The student is responsible for providing the following information to their clinical preceptor:

1. Clinical Preceptor Information (form 2)
2. Preceptor Evaluation (form 5)
3. Agency Agreement (form 1)
4. Course Syllabus
5. Information for Preceptors (form 6)

The student is responsible for submitting the completed Clinical Preceptor Information (form 2) and the Agency Agreement (form 1) to the on campus faculty by the designated due date. These forms must be submitted prior to the beginning of any clinical hours at that agency.

The student is responsible for submitting the following information to the on campus faculty by the last week of the semester:

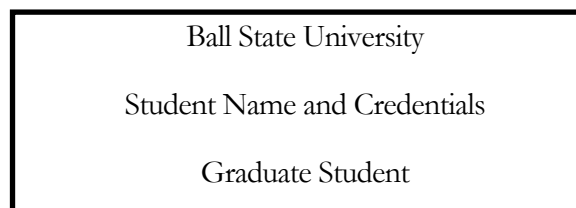
1. Preceptor Clinical Evaluation (form 5) ... (signed by student and preceptor)
2. Agency Evaluation (form 3)

Failure to submit forms by the designated due dates may be considered unsatisfactory clinical performance resulting in course failure.
