**STUDENT VERIFICATION OF TRAINING IN STANDARD (UNIVERSAL) PRECAUTIONS**

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According to the **Standard Precautions Rule 410 IAC 1-4 under Public Law 123-1988**: “An employer shall provide training and the necessary equipment to each employee and student trainee who has duties that require the employee to have direct contact with blood or body fluids in the scope of the employee’s employment.” This training must include instruction in the procedures “Universal Precautions” adopted by the Indiana State Board of Health.

Because nursing students may have direct contact with blood and other body fluids, the School of Nursing is requiring training in Universal Precautions. This form will be retained in the School of Nursing office as documentation of training in Universal Precautions.
